Stonesfield

Road resurfacing in Pond Hill will be scheduled for 23/24 although some Ptching will be done outside the shop area and some drainage unblocking in the parking areas. The hope is the owner will carry out some gutter clearance in the bays and some kerbside repairs in the same area.

Woodstock

Agreement to work together in furthering a health centre for Woodstock has been reached and further meetings are now arranged for September with all stakeholders.

The Library/hub has also been prioritised. More news to follow in the September report.

Tackley

Attending meeting with Tackley parish councillors and Network rail who have promised to action 2 options for further work/costings and report back in September to progress the crossing issue.

Wootton

Pleased to support the refurbishment costs of the Burbidge Hall in Wootton as part of an overall community effort to update and bring it back into full use under new management.

Arranged for drains to be jetted and weed clearance opposite Marriot Close and Milford Place
